The flowchart shows the Pedra Branca Farm as a direct supplier, but there are no records of purchases from the property; therefore, this information is incorrect.

It produced environmental regularization documentation, and is in compliance with the Monitoring Protocol of the Federal Prosecution Office.
	Vale Formoso Farm	The Vale Formoso Farm where, according to the report there was deforestation, does not figure on the active supplier base of JBS. The flowchart shows the Jaguari Farm as a direct supplier, but there are no records of purchases from the property; therefore, this information is incorrect.
